

## ***The Lord is My – SALVATION***

No matter what perils we face in life, God is our Salvation.

*(Psalm 38:22) Hurry to help me, Lord, my Savior.*

*(Psalm 65:5) Answer us in righteousness, with awe-inspiring works, God of our salvation, the hope of all the ends of the earth.*

*(Psalm 68:19) May the Lord be praised! Day after day He bears our burdens: God is our salvation.*

### **1. Savior**

- A. Israel knew that failing God always results in the same thing – **ruin**.
- B. David knew that failing God always results in the same thing – **pain**.
- C. Paul knew that failing God always results in the same thing – **death**.
- D. We should know that failing God always requires the same thing – **a Savior**.

### **2. Teacher**

*(Psalm 25:5) Guide me in Your truth and TEACH me, for You are the God of my salvation.*

*(Psalm 51:8 & 10) Let the bones You have crushed rejoice... God, create a clean heart for me.*

- A. God saved David's life.

*(Psalm 51:6) Surely You desire integrity in the inner self, and You TEACH me wisdom deep within.*

- B. God taught David wisdom.

*(Psalm 25:5) Guide me in YOUR truth and teach me, for You are the God of my salvation.*

- C. God taught David "HIS" wisdom.

### **3. Helper**

- A. Being our "Helper" includes more than being our "Savior"

*(Psalm 38:22) Hurry to HELP me, Lord, my Savior.*

*(Psalm 79:9) God of our salvation, HELP us – for the glory of Your name.*

- B. If God "was" your Savior yesterday, He "is" your helper today.

*(Psalm 46:1) God IS our refuge and strength, a HELPER who is ALWAYS found in times of trouble.*

### **4. Bearer**

*(Psalm 68:19) May the Lord be praised! Day after day He BEARS our burdens: God is our salvation.*

- A. If you ask God to carry your burden, He'll do it!
- B. With God carrying your burden, you no longer have to.
