More often than not, we are in AWE of the trivial instead of in AWE of the Trinity.

Scripture: Romans 11:33-36

Verse 35 shares about God as the ultimate GIVER and our inability to adequately repay Him for all that He is and all that He has done for us .

1) God is the source of all that is GOOD

a) God is the original definition of good.

Scripture: Psalm 119:68; Mark 10:18

b) God owes nothing to any of us; we are all absolutely dependent on God.

All of us are absolutely dependent on God all of the time.

Scripture: *Job 41:11- Who has a claim against me that I must pay? Everything under heaven belongs to me.*

2) Because God is GOOD, He GIVES generously

a) God gives to everyone all the time.

Scripture: Psalm 145:9, 13-17; James 1:17; Job 33:4; Isaiah 42:5

b) God gives the gift of His PRESENCE to His children.

Scripture: Psalm 34:7

3) As children of THE GOOD GIVER, we should reflect our FATHER

a) Before you gave God anything, God gave you EVERYTHING (Romans 8:32)

b) God gives to us out of His love, and asks us to share those gifts with others

c) God asks for our sin and He gives us salvation.
