 - (John 15:26) We would have never had access to the Holy Spirit.
 - (John 14:26) We would have never had any guidance or direction.
 - (John 14:13) We would have never had our prayers answered.
 - (John 14:21) We would have never personally experienced the love of God.
 - (Romans 8:1-2) We would have never escaped the condemnation of sin.
 - (Romans 8:15) We could have never been adopted by God.
 - (John 3:16) We could have never gone to heaven.
 - (Galatians 5:22-23) We could have never received and displayed Christ's traits.
 - (2 Timothy 1:7) We could have never lived life with Christ's courage, love, common sense.
 - (John 1:3) There would have never been an earth.
