C. The Problem

- The punishment according to the law of Moses was death by stoning.
- Her situation seemed hopeless.

- Jesus stoops and writes on the ground with his finger.
- Jesus stands up & makes a powerful statement.
- Jesus stoops again to draw in the dirt.
- Rocks fall. The religious leaders depart.
